

COMMERCIAL DRIVER'S LICENSE (CDL) TRUCK DRIVING TRAINING

About the Program

Prepare to pass a commercial driver's license test. You will learn basic and advanced procedures for operating a truck. Understand commercial driving safety, vehicle systems, and how to report malfunctions. This is a non-degree certificate program.

- Gain professional driving skills. Qualify for entry-level truck driving positions
- Earn a Class A Commercial Driver's License

Training begins monthly

- Theory: Complete online training in one month. Theory is offered every month
- Behind the wheel: 12 days, Mon-Fri 7:30 a.m. - 3:30 p.m. Behind the wheel training is scheduled on demand by Lake Superior College

Qualifications to attend

You must:

- Be a St. Louis County resident
- Be at least 18 years old
- Have access to a computer and reliable internet to complete the online theory modules
- Have reliable transportation
- Have a valid Minnesota or Wisconsin Class D driver's license
- Have a clean driving record for the past five years
- Pass the DOT physical exam and drug test

Priority enrollment is given if you are a BIPOC (Black, Indigenous, person of color) person, a female, or from an underrepresented community.
